Voiture 987 The Copper Queen



The Copper Queen Locomotive was built in Bisbee, AZ and was commissioned in 1934, making the "Queen" the oldest running locomotive in the United States.

She is operated and maintained by the members of Voiture 987, Grand du Arizona, 40/8. She has participated in numerous events in the United States, including a parade vehicle for President Franklin D. Roosevelt in Florida; our National Meetings (Promenade Nationale) in St. Louis, San Diego, Baton Rouge, Springfield, MO; and in many parades every year throughout Cochise County, AZ, and in parades and events all over the state of Arizona.

The 40/8 members will always keep her alive to support programs such as our Nurses Training Scholarship Program, POW/MIA Scholarship Program, Child Welfare Programs, Americanism, Youth Sports and the Carville Star (Hanson's Disease/Leprosy).

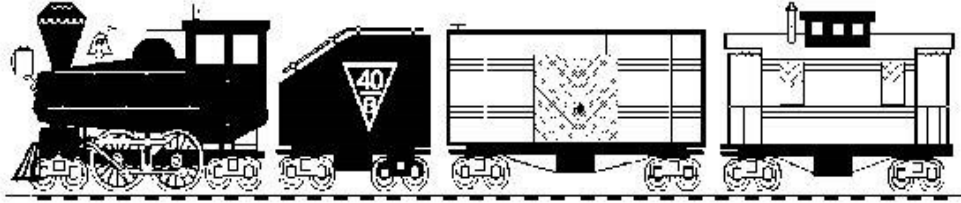
POW/MIA PROGRAM PINS
